Here are the Ladder 2015 results in order of Points.

This month we welcome John G7JMZ and Laurent F5OGJ to the Ladder.

The order of the highest six entrants is the same as last month except that OH7QR has moved up to 5th position. The top two, M5ABN and G4LHI, have consolidated their positions by pulling further away from the entrant below them – you'd expect this as time goes on. However, looking at the next four entrants (2E0DPH, G4KLE, G0ILN, OH7QR) exactly the *opposite* has happened – there are fewer points between each of them this month!
