Since most of our friends aren't hardboiled testers (of the 599qrz type) they may enjoy this event. It's great to hear Straight Keys in such a massive way....

Here's a summary of the rules.

EVENT	Straight Key Party (Handtasten Party, HTP)
DATE	1st Saturday in September, 1300 to 1600UTC
Frequencies	7,010 - 7,040 kHz (Observe your country bandplan)
Categories	A = up to 5W Output (or 10W Input) B = up to 50W Output (or 100W Input) C = up to 150W Output (or 300W Input) D = SWL
Exchange	RST and QSO-Number/Category/Name/Age (yl = xx). Example: 579007/A/Ernie/44 and 589009/B/Bertha/xx. It is mandatory to send the slashes.
Scoring	QSO-class A with class A = 9 points QSO-class A with class B = 7 points QSO-class A with class C = 5 points QSO-class B with class B = 4 points QSO-class B with class C = 3 points QSO-class C with class C = 2 points
LOGS	UTC, Band, Call, exchange sent, exchange received, class, station description used in the contest, final score claimed, word of honor to have used nothing else but a hand key. SWL-Logs must contain both calls and at least one complete rapport
NOTE	There are awards for the first, second and third place in each class and placement cards for each entrant. Non observance of the rules will lead to disqualification! All logs must contain a declaration that the contest rules have been respected. Send SASE or SAE plus one IRC to receive a list of the results (Be sure to add your complete postal address). The results will also be posted to the AGCW board of the Packet Radio BBS network and to the AGCW home page. Additionally, they will be published in 'AGCW-Info'.

Also, a reminder that the SKW (Straight Key Week) is running during September.

The 2nd to the 8th of September to be precise.

Here's a summary of the rules.

DATES	0001 UTC on 2nd September to 2359 on 8th September 07.
BANDS	All licensed amateur bands except the WARC bands.
SCORING	5 points FISTS club stations, 3 points for a FISTS affiliated Club Station, 2 points for a FIST Member, 1 point for a Non Member
EXCHANGE	RST/NAME/QTH/FIST No or NM/DAY No. Sunday is Day 1 Monday is Day 2 and so on To Saturday as Day 7.
GENERAL	All entrants must have used a straight Key for all their QSO's but the worked station Does not have to use a straight key. PLEASE vacate or pass on the FIST calling frequency after 5 continuous QSO's or QSY off the calling frequency.
LOGS	DATE/CALL/NAME/QTH/QRG/RST/TIME/FIST No or NM/DAY No/POINTS. Any contact not showing the required return information will be excluded from the total scores. Formats excepted: Excel (Preferred) csv. MS Word. Notepad. Wordpad. Etc.Paper logs, or 1.4Mb disc, CD Rom are accepted as are photocopies of your logbook (Readable please)
SEND TO:	All entries can be received by post to: R.D.Walker, 125, Devereux Road, West Bromwich. B70 6RQ. Or EMAIL In Excel format if possible please. (All entries to be received by the 22nd of September 2007)

Lets hope we hear the bands alive with members on their straight keys!

I hope to be active with GX3ZQS/p for one or two days during the activity. Listen out for me!
