

Here is my report per your request.

Quite a few years ago I used to spend the majority of my radio time on 30m and had lots of fun with it. It turned out to be the first band that my horribly inefficient antenna provided reasonably reciprocal RSTs along with quite a low noise level.

When I had a listen on 30m for the first time again this month, unfortunately I found an S9 noise level which it turns out is coming from an external source (on the other hand, fortunately a check of all the other bands showed that this is unique to 30m!)

Not to be completely defeated, I have listened from time-to-time for a really strong signal that wasn't calling "CQ DX" and eventually got rewarded with my one token QSO for the activity – OK2PVF.
